Subject Resident Programs at the Parks at Wynnewood

Joseph,

As I mentioned to you the other day, Buckner Children and Family Services, manages the on-site programs at the Parks. The programs offered fall into 5 categories which include Community Development, Empowerment, Health, Education, and Spiritual Enrichment. In terms of the number of residents served in each of these programs served during 2009, here are the totals in each category:

Community Development (social activities, crime watch, community gatherings, etc) : 1,196

Empowerment (job readiness, skills training, parenting skills, support groups, food/rent/utilities assistance): 1,894

Health (nutrition, health fairs, education, screenings): 185

Education (training, computer classes, career fairs, GED testing, after school program): 243

Spiritual Enrichment (prayer breakfasts, bible studies, outreach): 227

Obviously, a number of the residents have utilized a particular service or services multiple times. Still, there were approximately 3500 resident "touches" during the year which we feel is very noteworthy.

In addition to the Buckner staff and other volunteer organizations providing services, we had 33 different Parks residents volunteering their time during the year also.

Recently, Buckner has spear-headed an effort within the Parks community to have the residents help with aid to the people so devastated by the earthquake in Haiti. They are collecting various goods such as toiletry items, etc.

The on-site services component is a critically important part of the Parks at Wynnewood and I thought you might find it interesting. We provide these services at a substantial cost each year and have been doing so for the past 15 yrs.
